The other projects are either stand-alone with funds raised specifically to implement them, fully sponsored on a long-term basis, or they are self-funding, like the adult education courses. With 85 per cent of children at Bali Hati School on some form of scholarship; that is, whose parents pay a third of fees to no fees at all, the continuing annual short fall places a strain on the acquisition and/or updating of educational resources. Events such as this make a world of difference.

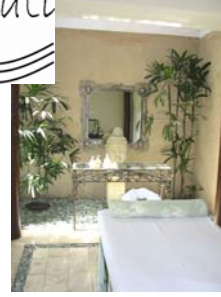
